15 min south of Dunedin Airport • Berwick Forest • Access via Berwick Road onto Webbs Road

Camp Rules & Conditions

- **No dogs** or pets permitted on site.
- **No glass** beer or RTD bottles. Wine bottles, cans and plastic bottles are acceptable. Please drink responsibly.
- Berwick Camp is a hunting-free zone. All aquatic life is protected — catch and release only.
- The climbing and abseiling walls must be used with ropes and an experienced climber present at all times.
- **No campfires.**

⚠ **Guests are expected to pay for any breakages, damages, or any additional cleaning that may be required.**

What to Bring

The following must be supplied by your group:

Bedding	All bedding and pillows (mattresses provided)
Personal	Toiletries, towels, tea towels and first aid kits.
Food	All food for your stay
Cleaning	Cleaning liquids and cloths (brooms, mops, buckets and vacuum supplied)
Bathroom	Toilet paper (please leave min 1 roll of toilet paper in each toilet) and paper towels (paper towel dispensers provided.) Hand soap pumps are provided, please leave full.
Rubbish	Remove all rubbish from bins and replace rubbish bins and bathroom bins with new bags on departure. Skip on site at extra charge.

Facilities Provided

Sleeping

The camp sleeps 65 people in 11 bunk rooms. All rooms sleep 6 people (3 bunks) except the Lion's Den which sleeps 9 (4 bunks, 1 single) and Kahikatea which has 2 single beds. The sick bay room has 1 bunk bed, so can sleep 2. All bunkrooms have heaters, insect repellent plugs and double-glazed windows.

Bathrooms

Male and female bathrooms each with 2 showers, 3 toilets each — 1 wheelchair accessible, plus 2 urinals in men's. Sauna area: 2 showers (1 wheelchair accessible) + 1 toilet.

Kitchen

Commercial grade: 2 ovens, 2 double cooktops, fridge, freezer, microwave, dish steriliser. Washing machine and continuous hot water dispenser. Full cookware and crockery. Ample bench space and 4 sinks.

Lounge & Dining

Dining room seats 65. Lounge with fireplace (firewood extra), 50" TV/HDMI, seating for 40, books/games. Covered deck with 2 BBQs, gas bottles provided.

Gymnasium

Large gym with basketball hoops and volleyball net. Bring your own sports equipment.

Drying Room

Drying room with heater, dehumidifier and drying racks.

Activities

- Confidence & initiative courses, orienteering, flying fox
- Kayaking on pond — life jackets provided (extra charge applies)
- Gym climbing wall — experienced climber and ropes required
- Outdoor abseiling wall — experienced climber and ropes required
- Walking tracks
